

Forest Friends is an innovative approach to outdoor learning where children progress their learning and development through leading their own explorations in our woodland and wild space. They explore and engage with the natural world using all of their senses, exploring the environment and developing a deep respect for nature. Forest Friends sessions impact positively on children's learning and development, increasing self-confidence, emotional resilience, independence, motivation to learn, team work, and social and communication skills.

Our early years unit is keen to promote awe and wonder for our children from pre-school through to foundation two, this is done by using aspects of a curiosity approach to their learning -by being curious about something it sparks our desire to learn, it creates an eagerness to explore, discover and use our critical thinking skills to problem solve solutions. This enables us to build the children's confidence to develop their own theories about the world around them.
