


Artists...

- Analyse and evaluate creative works, including their own, using artistic vocabulary.
- Compare similarities and differences between the work of different artists, craft makers and designers.
- Appreciate the work of great artists, craft makers and designers including an understanding of the historical and cultural development of their art forms.
- Use knowledge of other areas of the curriculum to support the application of disciplinary knowledge.
