Admission Published Admission Number consultation

Dear stakeholder,

The Governors and Senior Leadership Team of Bilsthorpe Flying High Academy, supported by the Flying High Trust propose to decrease the Published Admission Number (PAN) for new Reception pupils from 40 to 30, to take effect from September 2025.

The proposed change offers a number of benefits to the school and community:

- The current PAN of 40 presents significant financial challenges to the school in terms of staffing and resourcing. The PAN and required staffing, alongside the reality of actual numbers on roll sees the school facing a deficit budget within one academic year. To ensure sustainability of the school, this PAN reduction is pivotal.
- Creating discrete year group classes supports effective teaching and learning for the children (removal of the potential need for mixed classes with increased numbers).
- Place Planning data demonstrates that a PAN of 30 would meet the school place need for our school, including any new housing developments and projected children requiring school places.

The proposed change will not affect the current pupils or those who choose to accept an offer for a Reception place in September 2024. Anyone making an in-year admissions application during 2023-2024 and 2024-2025 will also not be affected by the proposed changes. All current and future parents and any other interested stakeholders can make comments on this proposal, information on how you can do this is detailed below, under the section titled "How to make your views known".

Over-subscription criteria:

The over-subscription criteria will remain unchanged.

It is important to the school to consider the views of our parents and the wider community. As set out in the Schools Admission Code, we are entering into a 6-week statutory consultation. Following the consultation, the school shall formally apply for the proposed changes.
