Enquiry: How do we express creativity?

This term, our subject driver is Art. To enable us to answer our enquiry question, we will be looking at two different artists: Jean Le Noir and LS Lowry. We will be comparing and contrasting their work, before developing some of our art skills and producing a piece in the style of our chosen artists. Alongside this, we will also be developing our Design Technology skills and creating a house in the style of LS Lowry. We will also be looking at influential musicians and complementing our ukulele instruction with other musical instruments.

English

We will use this text to learn about the features of a playscript. We will also be developing our poetry skills, as well as learning about folk tales and producing some high quality pieces of writing in each of these genres.



Maths



Year 3 we will be continuing our learning about money and time. We will also learn about fractions and shapes. We will be learning our timetables too, please support your child by practising at home. The children have all the timestables in the back of their reading diaries.

Reminders:

- Every child needs to have their reading diary and reading book in school every day - reading diaries will be checked throughout the week and children will be provided with a new reading book when one is needed. Children should aim to read 3 or 4 times a week.
