## Enquiry: Are all changes for the good of everyone?

In History we will be carrying out research and learning about key events during the Ancient Greek Empire. We will be learning about important changes that were brought in during this period and how many of them still impact on our lives today.

In Design and Technology we will be designing and making a piece of Greek footwear. We will be learning about different ways to attach materials and when completed will be evaluating our end product.

## English

This half term we will be learning what makes a good narrative using the story The Iron Man. We look forward to bringing our stories home to share with you.

After half term we will move onto performance poetry, learning about how to present to an audience using both our voice and actions.

## Maths

We start the year in maths with a unit on place value where we will be learning all about numbers, looking at the value of each digit and how we can show the numbers using equipment.

Following this unit, we will move onto a unit on addition and subtraction where we will be using exchanging to solve problems.
