Can you recreate one of Vincent Van Gogh's paintings? You could draw, paint, sketch or make a collage!



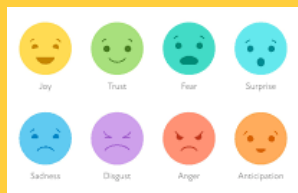
### Create a piece of artwork representing emotion.



Create some artwork that represents an emotion, choosing colours and lines carefully to do this.

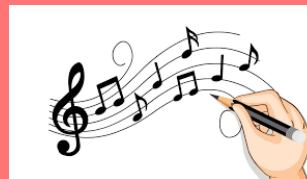
### Write a poem
