Enquiry: Is it only when we govern ourselves that we are well governed?

To enable us to answer our enquiry question, we will be going back in time to the Ancient Romans. We will be learning about the developments and changes that took place during the invasion and occupation of Britain by the Romans. and we will be considering whether these changes were for the better. We will begin to design our own piece of roman clothing as well. We hope some adults will be able to support pupils in class in learning these skills. So much exciting learning will be happening!

English

We begin Year 4 with Julius Caesars invasions of Britain and creating a newspaper report around this historical figure. After we will create a themed narrative piece on the Roman invasion from a Briton's perspective using the story Roman Invasion by Jim Eldridge.

Maths

To begin Year 4 we will be learning about Place Value and the four operations of addition, subtraction, multiplication and division

To support your child at home, you could count up in thousands and rounding to the nearest 1, 10, 100 or 1000.
