Welcome to F2!

What a great first couple of weeks we have had back at school! . Myself, and the team are really excited to make this year a great one. Please read our newsletter as it will hopefully give you all the information you need and answer some of the questions you may have.

Enquiry:

Our Enquiry is split into two questions this term: "What makes me, me?" and "What makes somebody special?". We will be looking at ourselves as individuals, and our families. We will be looking at the past and present and comparing the changes using the terms 'older' and 'younger'. The children will be exposed to a range of significant people to begin to understand what it takes to make someone special.

As part of our Enquiry we would love for you to send a photo of your child as a baby and a family photograph via Class Dojo so we can use these in class discussions.

English/Phonics:

This half term we will be focusing on name writing and recognition. We will be beginning to identify and write initial sounds in words.

As a school we have chosen to follow the No Nonsense phonics scheme. I will be sending home a document to further support this in the coming weeks.

Maths:

This half term in Maths we will be developing our understanding of matching and grouping.

We will also be exploring numbers to 10 focusing on what the number looks like, how to form it and how we can make it. During this time the children will be exposed to a range of manipulatives to choose from.

Reminders:

- Each child in F2 will have their own reading diary and reading book. Please can you ensure these are in school every day so an adult can read with your child. These books will be changed regularly and diaries checked weekly. It would be great to see you reading with your child at home and recording this in the diary along with any comments (these all go towards the reading star treat at the end of the term!)
- Foundation 2 will be having PE once a week. F2's PE day is a Monday. On this day the children can come into school in the correct PE kit. Please can earrings be removed at home prior or covered with tape.
- Foundation 2 will take part in Forest Friends every Friday. If your child has a pair of wellies to wear during this session, that would be fantastic! We are more than happy for your child to leave these at school. Please ensure your child has warm clothing and a spare change of clothes as we will be outside in all weathers.
