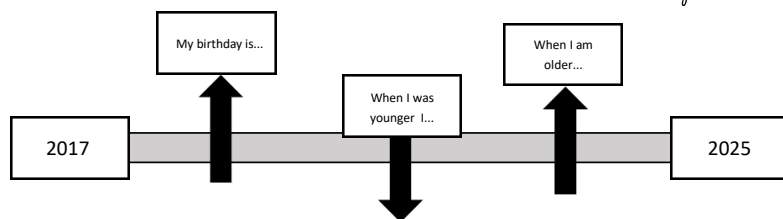


## Sticky Knowledge








- The days of the week are Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday.
- The days of the weekend are Saturday and Sunday
- A new year starts in our country on the 1st January.
- My birthday happens once every year on the same day.

- Younger means having lived less time than someone else.
- Past events might include anniversaries, weddings, birthdays, Christmas, bonfire night etc.

- Past events in the local community often have impact on future events.
- Stories can tell us about people from the past.
- Each family is made up of a variety of different members.

- A consequence is the result or outcome of an action or decision.
