Country		A country is made up of land and people. The country we live in is England.
United Kingdom		The United Kingdom is made up of England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland.
City		A place in which people live and work. A city is bigger than a town and has more shops etc..
Feature		Environmental features are the land of the natural environment e.g. rivers and mountains.
Habitat		The place or environment where an animals lives.
Environment		An environment is the area in which a person, plant or animal lives and operates.
Map		A visual representation of an area.
