Enquiry: Why leave a legacy?

This term's enquiry focuses on the creative arts.

At the start of the term we will be creating artwork in the style of Banksy. Then, using inspiration from artist Fred Ferdegens, we will create wire word sculptures linked to our legacy—this will provide inspiration to younger children for years to come. Later in the term, we will be looking at Frida Kahlo's work to inspire our own self portraits. We will create artwork inspired by Henry Moore and towards the end of the term, we will create a Mayan sculpture using clay. We will be enhancing our art enquiry with history where we will focus on the legacy left by miners as well as the legacy left by the Mayan civilisation.

English

A lot of our English work this term will be based on the book, "Pig Heart Boy" by Malorie Blackman. We'll be writing a narrative based on the book. We'll also link our writing to the science learning and write an explanation text about the heart.

Maths

In the lead up to SATs, we will be revising all areas of maths as well as working on our arithmetic skills.

Later in the term, we'll be applying our problem solving skills to real-life situations.
