Enquiry:

Our Enquiry is split into two questions this term: 'Do we all have the same imagination?' and 'How do we celebrate our differences?'. This term our driver is creative arts meaning we will be learning about different artists (Kandinsky) and illustrators (Eric Carle). We will be comparing these, looking at past and present artwork and giving opinions backed up with reasoning. The outcome of Summer 1 will be to create a piece of artwork inspired by Kandinsky, thinking about style, pattern and colour. During Summer 2 we will be creating an 'all about me' booklet containing self portraits and things which make the children unique.

English/Phonics:

This half term we will be looking at a range of stories and introducing traditional tales. We will continue our focus on sequencing, re-telling and describing characters within these. We will be encouraging the children to begin to extend their writing into short sentences using their knowledge of codes and common exception words to form these.

Maths:

This half term in Maths we will be beginning to compare and measure mass and capacity identifying which containers are full and empty. We will be continuing to deepen our understanding of number to 10 and the composition of each number. We will be working towards the children independently recalling number bonds to 10 and recognising the pattern of the counting system beyond 20.

Reminders:

- Each child in F2 will have their own reading diary and two reading books. Please can you ensure these are in school every day so a member of the F2 team can read with your child. These books will be changed regularly and diaries checked weekly. Please remember to also write in your child's diary if they have read at home (for it to be counted towards the reading treat!).
- Foundation 2 will be having PE once a week. The children will be having PE on a Monday. PE kits can be worn on the day of PE. PE kits should be named and include a white t-shirt, blue/black shorts or jogging bottoms, a plain black/navy jacket/hoodie and trainers/black plimsols.
- Foundation 2 will continue to take part in Forest Friends every Friday afternoon. If your child has a pair of wellies to wear during this session, that would be fantastic! We are more than happy for your child to leave these at school. Please ensure your child has warm clothing as we will be outside in most weathers. Any questions, or concerns please come and see one of the EYFS team
- The 'this week we are learning' document will be added to class dojo weekly to give you an insight into what the children will be learning about that current week.
