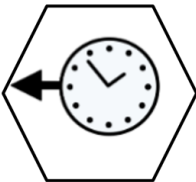
The months of the year are January, February, March, April, May, June, July, August, September, October, November, December.



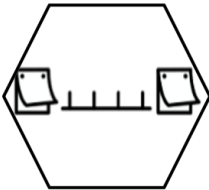
My birthday happens once every year on the same day.

Facts are things that are known or proved to be true.



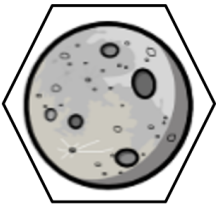
Changes in transport have made it faster to get places.
